Elected in November of 2000, Ms. Polk is the first female to hold the office of Yavapai County Attorney; she is currently serving her 3rd 4-year term. As County Attorney, Ms. Polk manages a staff of 100 employees, with both criminal and civil duties, and an annual budget of 7 million dollars. The Office prosecutes all felony and juvenile offenses that occur in Yavapai County, misdemeanors that occur in the unincorporated areas of the County, and provides legal representation to all county departments. In addition to her administrative duties, Ms. Polk personally prosecutes major felony offenders, including financial abuse cases involving elderly victims.
